We are organizing our voucher fundraising effort that will lead up to MaST's Annual Raffle Weekend. Every year, the proceeds from the Raffle are used to fund new projects and spaces for our school community. Enclosed are fifteen (15) ten-dollar voucher tickets for the contest. Please see the summary of how the contest works and the prize list below:

How it works:

- Each student will receive an envelope with their name and (15) ten-dollar vouchers enclosed with this letter.
- Sell all fifteen (15) ten-dollar vouchers, and the seller is automatically entered into the drawing for all three prizes.
- Sell ten (10) ten-dollar vouchers, and the seller is entered into the drawing for the second and third prizes.
- Sell five (5) ten-dollar vouchers, and the seller is entered into the drawing for the third prize.
- The top seller will win the prize listed below.
- The voucher purchasers will have the chance to win the purchaser prize listed below.

Prizes:

- **Third Prize** - Gift Card Package for \$250
- **Top Seller** - Xbox One X
